VCE Biology Workshops 2024

The School of BioSciences is running workshops for students to complete practical activities supporting Unit 4, VCE Biology. The program comprises the following activities:



• An investigation into response to an infectious disease outbreak using an ELISA test (Outcome 1)

AND

Analyse the evidence for genetic changes that effect populations and changes in species over time, using
 Drosophila melanogaster as a model (Outcome 2)

All laboratory sessions will run for 2 hours and will be in the Mendel Laboratory ground floor <u>Food and Nutrition</u> <u>Building</u> (Building 194, Old Genetics) at the University's Parkville campus.

- Qualified demonstrators (with valid working with children check) from the School of BioSciences will provide individual assistance to students (one staff member per 8-12 students).
- Teachers are expected to verify their students' completion of work as per their school's requirements.
- Any class size is welcome. Small classes from different schools may be combined in the same session.
- The School of BioSciences will supply all materials except printed notes.

The cost is \$35 (incl. GST) per student

(this covers the disposable lab coat, consumables, and staffing)
